



## Invitation: ERC Starting and Consolidator Grant Writing Course

This September, the Grants and Innovation Office (FIK) offers a course on how to write a competitive ERC Starting or Consolidator Grant research proposal. The course consists of two parts. The first 2 days are open to all researchers at the University of Gothenburg and the last 2 days will be in the form of an interactive workshop at Hjortviken Conference Hotel, where up to ten participants will be invited to participate. The course will be given in English.

### Course dates:

#### **September 5, 9.00 - 17.00 (including coffee/tea and light lunch)**

Seminar: Writing Successful ERC Starting & Consolidator Grant Proposals. The workshop is led by Aya van den Kroonenberg from Yellow Research (open to all researchers but requires [registration](#)).

#### **September 15th, 13.00 - 15.00**

Seminar: Inspirational talks by Professor Staffan Lindberg and Professor Maria Falkenberg Gustafsson including a brief introduction to the templates (no registration required).

#### **September 22, 9.00 – September 23, 17.00 (overnight)**

Interactive workshop covering all parts of the proposal. You are expected to bring with you a draft of your proposal. Short introductions and lectures by research advisors from FIK are followed by time to work on your own draft with access to the advisors. Each draft will then be collectively reviewed and commented by your fellow participants and the advisors.

Venue: Hjortviken Conference Hotel, Hindås. Free of charge for the participant.
