Instructions for BECC travels

BECC pays for travel for researchers travelling to a BECC event. The university that you are employed at pays for your travel, so if you are a researcher at LU –LU pays.

Both Lund University and University of Gothenburg has an agreement with the travel agency Egencia. All trips shall be booked through them.

If you are a BECC researcher at Lund University and travelling to an event organized by BECC (e.g. a Theme meeting) outside of Lund please book your tickets by travel agency Egencia (<http://www.staff.lu.se/support-and-tools/business-travel/how-to-book-a-trip>) and send the invoice, with a small note about reason for travel, through Lupin to Lina Nikoleris.

Researchers from University of Gothenburg

Book travel and accommodation with travel agency “Egencia Göteborg”, 031-7738715, customer_service@egencia.se. State the order identity (“beställar-id”) of Håkan Pleijel “3130BPLEHA”, when you make your booking.
